~ 2009 League Details ~

○ **Participant eligibility:**

- Must be a current member of a Varsity or JV High School Golf Team
- Must have a letter of recommendation from your current coach
- Must have completely filled out the registration form with a parents / guardians signature

○ **League format:**

- USGA Rules will govern all play
- 18 Hole stroke play
- League will run for 12 weeks
- Each player will compete within one of the 4 divisions:
 1. Girls JV – Gold Tees
 2. Boys JV – Blue Tees
 3. Girls Varsity – Gold Tees
 4. Boys Varsity – Black Tees

○ **League Awards:**

- To be eligible for the following league awards a participant must attend league a minimum of 10 days. The following payout is subject to change based on the number of participants. A League Awards Presentation will be scheduled at the conclusion of the final league day.
- 1 Over-all Champion – Low scoring average
 - Can come out of any division
 - \$100.00 Ravenwood Gift Certificate
- 4 Division Champions – Low Scoring Average
 - \$50.00 Ravenwood Gift Certificate
- 4 Most Improved Awards – The differential of scoring average between weeks 1 - 6 and weeks 7 - 12
 - \$25.00 Ravenwood Gift Certificate
- Weeks 1 – 6 awards, (1 winner from each division - \$25.00 each):
 - Low 9 hole score for the front 9
 - Low 9 hole score for the back 9
 - Low 18 hole score
- Weeks 7 – 12 Awards, (1 winner from each division - \$25.00 each):
 - Low 9 hole score for the front 9
 - Low 9 hole score for the back 9
 - Low 18 hole score

○ **Pairings and tee times:**

- Weekly pairings will be random – no requests will be allowed

- Your tee time may fluctuate week to week within the tee time schedule listed below.
Generally, you will be paired with others in your division
- If you know you will be unable to participate in one or more weeks, please let us know no later than 48 hours in advance
- Tee times will run at 9 minute intervals with the first time beginning at 4:03 and the last tee time scheduled for 5:06
- An email will be sent to each league participant on Friday evening
- A 4 hour minimum pace of play requirement will be enforced weekly by tournament coordinators

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE

Guaranteed Confirmation of League participation

A guaranteed confirmation for a League spot will occur upon receipt of the League fee in full and the completed signed application agreement and rules and regulation form.

Refunds

A League Membership will be prorated in the event there is a family job transfer or a medical disability with written notification from your doctor.

GOLF COURSE

Refusal of Privileges

Ravenwood Golf Club shall have the right to refuse golf course privileges to anyone, who in the judgement of the club management, violates the established rules and regulations as stipulated by the club herein.

Personal Property

Annual Members and all other Guests are reminded not to leave valuables (golf clubs, jewelry, etc.) unguarded in their vehicles or on any fairway or green. The club will not be responsible for lost or stolen property.

Decorum

Our dress code requires that collared shirts are to be worn by men and proper golf attire by women while on the golf course at all times. Blue jeans, tank tops, jogging/tennis shoes, cut-offs, or swimsuits are not permitted. Juniors are also required to abide by the dress code. The Practice Range does not allow short shorts, swim suits, tank tops, or cut offs – shirts and shoes are required.

Each player must wear golf or tennis shoes. RAVENWOOD GOLF CLUB is a soft spike club - metal spikes are not permitted.

Each player must have a set of golf clubs when playing the golf course. No more than one player shall play out of one bag. Rental clubs are available.

Behavior that is obnoxious to other players, including the use of abusive/profane language is not permitted. Anyone deemed to be acting in such a manner will be asked to leave and will not be refunded.

Golf Carts

No carts will be allowed during League Play.

Liability

The club assumes no responsibility or liability whatsoever for any injury or damage caused to persons or property resulting from play on the golf course.

It is the personal responsibility for golfers, who are exposed to the various hazards and liabilities that may arise from golf play, to provide insurance protection for the purpose of guarding themselves and their property against such liabilities.

Players on the golf course are expected to report immediately to the club, any injury or damage to persons or property cause by him or her.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICES***Consumption***

All food and beverages consumed on the club's property must be purchased from the club.

Alcohol

Food and beverages shall be served and consumed only in accordance with New York State laws. Any and all liquor law violations are prohibited on the club's property.

Coolers

Coolers, unless provided and stocked by the club, are not permitted on the golf course.

PARKING

All persons must drive and park motor vehicles in accordance with posted and marked regulations within Ravenwood Golf Club.

Only golf course maintenance vehicles are allowed on the golf course.

The club will not be responsible for loss or damage to automobiles driven or parked on the club's property.
